A group of four young musicians, through the Swiss Habisreutinger Stradivari foundation equipped with four of the finest instruments by Stradivari., has given their debut concert in the Kioi Hall, Tokyo. With the String Quartet No. 49 by Joseph Haydn (the frog), the Adagio from the second movement of Samuel Barber's "String Quartet No. 1 "and the String quartet (the "American") of Dvorak.

The Ensemble also presented their members in solo performances, with famous pieces. Violinist Soyoung Yoon played the last movement of Vivaldi's "Summer", Maja Weber on the Violoncello the "Swan" by Saint-Saens, Lech Antonio Uszynski the first movement from the Viola Concerto in c minor by Bach and the first violinist, Xiaoming Wang performed Czardas by Monti.

They all have showed their great talent. It was a fantastic listening experience.
